

**MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC HEARING HELD BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF
THE VILLAGE OF RIVERVIEW, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, HELD ON
OCTOBER 28, 2010.**

BE IT REMEMBERED THAT the Board of Trustees of the Village of Riverview, St. Louis County, Missouri, met at City Hall, 9699 Lilac Drive at 6:00 p.m. on October 28, 2010.

At the time and place, upon roll being called, there were found to be present the following named officers and members of the Board.

Village Clerk Megan Asikainen and Village Attorney Christopher B. Graville were also present.

There being a quorum present, the meeting was called to order by Chairman Steve Paro in order to discuss revocation of the merchant's license for Rite-Way Auto, 201 Chambers Road.

Attorney Graville explained that the hearing had been continued to this date at the request of Moumen Kuziez. Attorney Graville noted for the record that Mr. Kuziez had requested the suspension of his merchant's license at the previous hearing, pending the outcome of the continued hearing. No one was present on behalf of Rite Way Auto. After waiting approximately fifteen minutes after the opening of the hearing, the bailiff called the hall for Moumen Kuziez or anyone present on his behalf. There was no response.

Ms. Asikainen informed the Board of Trustees that Patrice Noland had applied for and was issued a merchant license for Upgrade Rite Auto, 201 Chambers Road, conditionally until December 31, 2010 to allow him time to present the Village with all proper licenses. Attorney Graville recommended that the Board revoke the merchant license issued to Moumen Kuziez for the business Rite-Way Auto due to the violation of the Village Code by operating the business in an unlawful manner by transferring or assigning the business license granted to Moumen Kuziez for Rite-Way Auto to another individual.

A motion was made by Bruce Stocker and seconded by Trustee Craig Boehmer to make a finding of fact that Moumen Kuziez violated Village Code Section 600.150 by transferring or assigning the business license granted to Moumen Kuziez for the business Rite-Way Auto. By roll call vote:
