

**MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL OPEN MEETING HELD BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF THE VILLAGE OF RIVERVIEW, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, HELD ON
MARCH 25, 2010.**

BE IT REMEMBERED THAT the Board of Trustees of the Village of Riverview, St. Louis County, Missouri, met at City Hall, 9699 Lilac Drive at 6:00 p.m. on March 25, 2010.

At the time and place, upon roll being called, there were found to be present the following named officers and members of the Board.

Village Clerk Megan Asikainen, Attorney Christopher Graville, and Jay Wohlschlaeger and Shannon Mahoney of SWT Design were also present.

There being a quorum present, the meeting was called to order by Chairman Steve Paro in order to discuss the park master plan for the Village lot on Diamond Drive.

Jay Wohlschlaeger of SWT Design, Inc. presented the Board with two concept drawings for a park to be created on a vacant lot on Diamond Drive between Fork and Northridge. The Village purchased the lot from the Riverview Gardens School District in 2009. Mr. Wohlschlaeger explained that the Village had received a park planning grant from the St. Louis County Municipal Park Grant Commission to create a master plan for this new park and that his firm was hired to do the design work. He explained the features of the two concept drawings and stated that his firm had taken into consideration citizen input using responses from a survey sent out with the Village newsletter. He said that this master plan was intended to be a guide for the Village to build the park as funds become available. He said that a comment board would be placed in the lobby of City Hall until the end of April for additional citizen comments which would be integrated into the final design to be discussed in May.

With no further business to discuss, a motion was made by Trustee Bruce Stocker and seconded by Trustee Phyllis Paro to adjourn the meeting. All Trustees voted in the affirmative, the motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 6:45 p.m.
