

MINUTES OF THE EMERGENCY SPECIAL OPEN MEETING HELD BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF RIVERVIEW, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, HELD ON APRIL 25, 2011.

BE IT REMEMBERED THAT the Board of Trustees of the Village of Riverview, St. Louis County, Missouri, met at City Hall, 9699 Lilac Drive at 12:00 p.m. on April 25, 2011.

At the time and place, upon roll being called, there were found to be present the following named officers and members of the Board.

Building Commissioner Dan Fraley was also present. There being a quorum present, the meeting was called to order by Chairman Steve Paro in order to discuss the Village's tornado recovery and potential participation in a program through St. Louis County to remove debris from the April 22, 2011 tornado.

Tornado Recovery and Debris Removal.

Trustee Paro opened the meeting by stating that the Village Building Commissioner, Dan Fraley, had been in contact with the St. Louis County Emergency Management office and several other agencies regarding the tornado recovery. She said that the St. Louis County program participation was voluntary, but that if the Village participated in the program, it could reduce the Village's costs and expedite the debris removal. She said that it would also simply the Village's FEMA and/or SEMA reimbursement if we were to be eligible for such. Building Commissioner Fraley updated the Board on the progress of the tornado recovery and the damage sustained in the Village. Trustee Paro gave the Board members the most recent information regarding the recovery efforts from St. Louis County. She said that this meeting had to be called on an emergency basis because St. Louis County needed to know which municipalities were participating by the end of the day. The Trustees reviewed information from St. Louis County regarding the program. A motion was made by Trustee Phyllis Paro and seconded by Trustee Bruce Stocker to participate in the St. Louis County debris removal program.

Riverview Fire Protection District Chief Joe Bommarito entered the meeting and updated the Board on the tornado recovery and the efforts made by volunteers to come in and assist the residents with the debris removal. He provided the Village with waiver forms to allow Americorp volunteers to enter the properties and assist with the cleanup.

With no further business to discuss, a motion was made by Trustee Howard Pierce and seconded by Trustee Craig Boehmer to adjourn the meeting. All Trustees voted in the affirmative, the motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 12:35 p.m.
