

MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL OPEN MEETING HELD BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF RIVERVIEW, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, HELD ON MAY 25, 2010.

BE IT REMEMBERED THAT the Board of Trustees of the Village of Riverview, St. Louis County, Missouri, met at City Hall, 9699 Lilac Drive at 6:00 p.m. on May 25, 2010.

At the time and place, upon roll being called, there were found to be present the following named officers and members of the Board.

Village Clerk Megan Asikainen was also present.

There being a quorum present, the meeting was called to order by Chairman Steve Paro in order to discuss the park master plan for the Village lot on Diamond Drive.

Chairman Paro called for Citizen's Comments on the proposed park designs. There were no citizens present who wished to comment.

The Board reviewed the comments left by the public on a message board that was displayed in City Hall through the end of April. Trustee Paro stated that there were some teenagers who came to the Open House event held a few weeks prior that said that they would like to have a large open space left in the center for playing softball or baseball and that they did not want to have a basketball court.

Ms. Asikainen responded if the Board could come to a consensus on the type of design, elements such as the basketball court could be added in the future.

The Board discussed the two plans and the design elements of each plan.

A motion was made by Trustee Phyllis Paro and seconded by Trustee Craig Boehmer to approve the Park B design removing the basketball court and the middle section of the walking path, moving the playground and pavilion to the front part of the park, removing the fencing and trees around the edges, keeping a welcome center at the front section but placing benches instead of a sign, removing the bioswale in the center, adding additional parking on the front part adjacent to Diamond Drive, and placing brick posts on the corners. All Trustees voted in the affirmative, the motion carried.

The Board was in agreement to have a Public Hearing on June 24, 2010 at 6:30 p.m. to review the final plan if available by that date.

With no further business to discuss, a motion was made by Trustee Bruce Stocker and seconded by Trustee Phyllis Paro to adjourn the meeting. All Trustees voted in the affirmative, the motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 6:40 p.m.
