

MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL OPEN MEETING HELD BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF RIVERVIEW, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, HELD ON MAY 6, 2011.

BE IT REMEMBERED THAT the Board of Trustees of the Village of Riverview, St. Louis County, Missouri, met at City Hall, 9699 Lilac Drive at 5:00 p.m. on May 6, 2011.

At the time and place, upon roll being called, there were found to be present the following named officers and members of the Board.

Village Clerk Megan Asikainen was also present.

Discuss contracting with St. Louis County for temporary code enforcement services.

Ms. Asikainen said that earlier in the week Electrical Inspector Jerry Gassel resigned unexpectedly. She said that there are several options that the Village can consider long-term, but that in the short term there are pending inspections that need to be completed. Ms. Asikainen said that she and the Building Commissioner had been in contact with St. Louis County. She said that the County Council had recently enacted an ordinance which allows them to contract with individual communities for electrical inspection services on a temporary basis at the rate of \$50.00 per hour for up to six months. She said that the St. Louis County legal department was still in the process of tying up some loose ends in the contract, but that the Village could consider this option until something more firm is agreed upon. Trustee Phyllis Paro said that she had been in contact with the Building Commissioner and she was aware that there were several residents without power from the tornado waiting for inspections. She encouraged the other Board members to approve the temporary contract so that the power could be restored to these residents as quickly as possible. A motion was made by Trustee Bruce Stocker and seconded by Trustee Craig Boehmer to contract with St. Louis County to provide electrical inspection services at the rate of \$50.00 per hour temporarily for up to six months and to authorize Chairman Steve Paro to sign said contract upon receipt by the Village and review by the Village Attorney.
