

MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC HEARING HELD BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF RIVERVIEW, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, HELD ON JUNE 24, 2010.

BE IT REMEMBERED THAT the Board of Trustees of the Village of Riverview, St. Louis County, Missouri, met at City Hall, 9699 Lilac Drive at 6:30 p.m. on June 24, 2010.

At the time and place, upon roll being called, there were found to be present the following named officers and members of the Board.

Village Clerk Megan Asikainen and Village Attorney Christopher B. Graville were also present.

There being a quorum present, the meeting was called to order by Chairman Steve Paro in order to discuss the allocation of \$24,000.00 of Community Development Block Grant Funds for the 2011 fiscal year.

Village Clerk Megan Asikainen stated that the Village had been informed that there was a \$24,000 allocation of CDBG funds for the 2011 year, the same as the allocation for the current year. She said that the 2010 funds were being used to create the park on Diamond Drive between Fork and Northridge. The Public Hearing handout was read.

Trustee Bruce Stocker asked if there were any houses that had been burned and were in a dangerous state. Trustee Craig Boehmer responded that there was a house on Coburg. Ms. Asikainen said that the Village had been dealing with the family on having the house torn down. Trustee Boehmer reported that there is a potentially dangerous house on Stimson Drive as well, but that the Village did not want to tear down any more houses unless it was a last resort.

Ms. Asikainen said that SWT Design, the park planning group, was going to present the Board with revised park plans based on citizen comments and on the Board's comments from the May park meeting. She said that this revised plan would include a cost estimate for the creation of the park. She suggested that the Board use the 2010 funds as planned to do the preparation work for the park, the grading and tree removal, then use the 2011 funds to continue the work on the park. She said that the Village also intends to apply to the St. Louis County Municipal Park Grant Commission for funds for the creation of the park in the fall of 2010.

Chairman Paro called for citizen's comments regarding the CDBG fund allocation. There were no citizens present who wished to comment.

A motion was made by Trustee Bruce Stocker and seconded by Trustee Craig Boehmer to allocate \$24,000 of Community Development Block Grant Funds for the creation of the park on Diamond Drive between Fork Drive and Northridge Drive. All Trustees voted in the affirmative, the motion carried.

With no further business to discuss, a motion was made by Trustee Howard Pierce and seconded by Trustee Craig Boehmer to adjourn the meeting. All Trustees voted in the affirmative, the motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 6:50 p.m.
