

**MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL OPEN MEETING HELD BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES  
OF THE VILLAGE OF RIVERVIEW, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, HELD ON  
AUGUST 4, 2009.**

**BE IT REMEMBERED THAT** the Board of Trustees of the Village of Riverview, St. Louis County, Missouri, met at City Hall, 9699 Lilac Drive at 6:00 p.m. on August 4, 2009.

At the time and place, upon roll being called, there were found to be present the following named officers and members of the Board.

Chairman Steve Paro	Present

There being a quorum present, the meeting was called to order by Chairman Steve Paro in order to open sealed bids for the purchase and installation of a drinking fountain at 10045 Toelle Lane and the purchase and installation of cement trash receptacles at various locations throughout the Village.

Trustee Phyllis Paro opened the sealed bids for the purchase and installation of cement trash receptacles at various locations throughout the Village and read them aloud. The bids received are summarized as follows:

Diverse Construction	\$17,500.00
DuraSeal Paving Contractor	\$14,600.00
Tramar Contracting	\$14,700.00
All Inclusive Rec	\$ 7,076.82

Trustee Paro reported that there was no installation description provided for the bid from Diverse Construction or All Inclusive Rec, but that DuraSeal proposed installing the receptacles on 3' x 3' concrete pads 8" deep and that Tramar Contracting proposed installing the receptacles on 5' x 5' concrete pads 6" deep.

A motion was made by Trustee Howard Pierce and seconded by Trustee Bruce Stocker to accept the bid from DuraSeal Paving Contractor in the amount of \$14,600.00 for the purchase and installation of cement trash receptacles at various locations throughout the Village. All Trustees present voted in the affirmative, the motion carried.

Trustee Phyllis Paro opened the sealed bids for the purchase and installation of a drinking fountain at 10045 Toelle Lane and read them aloud. The bids received are summarized as follows:

Diverse Construction	\$9,980.00
Roto Rooter Services Co.	\$6,736.98

Trustee Paro reported that there was no installation description provided for the bid from Diverse Construction, but that Roto Rooter was going to remove the existing hydrant on the water line and install new 3/4" copper service line from the meter approximately 100

feet to the proposed water fountain location, pour the concrete pad for the fountain to be anchored to, and install the water fountain.

A motion was made by Trustee Howard Pierce and seconded by Trustee Bruce Stocker to accept the bid from Roto Rooter Services Co. in the amount of \$6,736.98 for the purchase and installation of a drinking fountain at 10045 Toelle Lane. All Trustees present voted in the affirmative, the motion carried.

With no further business to discuss, a motion was made by Trustee Howard Pierce and seconded by Trustee Phyllis Paro to adjourn the meeting. All Trustees voted in the affirmative, the motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 6:45 p.m.
