**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CHAPTER 205 OF THE VILLAGE OF RIVERVIEW
MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING THE BOARD OF POLICE COMMISSIONERS.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF
RIVERVIEW, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section One.

Chapter 205 of Title II of the Village of Riverview, Missouri, Municipal Code is hereby amended by the repeal of Chapter 205 in its entirety as follows:

TITLE II PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY, AND WELFARE

~~CHAPTER 205 BOARD OF POLICE COMMISSIONERS~~

~~SECTION 205.010: COMPOSITION OF BOARD~~

~~The Board of Police Commissioners shall be composed of five (5) members and two (2) alternates, whose terms of office shall be for two (2) years and until their respective successors are appointed and have qualified.~~

~~SECTION 205.020: TERM OF OFFICE~~

~~The initial terms of office of the regular members of the Board of Police Commissioners immediately following the enactment of this Section shall be as follows: two (2) for one (1) year and three (3) for two (2) years, which shall expire on the thirtieth (30th) day of June of the applicable year. The initial terms of office of alternate members immediately following the enactment of this Section shall be as follows: one (1) for one (1) year and one (1) for two (2) years which shall expire on the thirtieth (30th) day of June of the applicable year. Thereafter, the Board of Police Commissioners shall be appointed by the Board of Trustees for terms of two (2) years each, which shall expire on the thirtieth (30th) day of June of the applicable year. If a vacancy occurs on the Board of Police Commissioners for any reason other than term expiration, the Board of Trustees shall appoint a successor who shall complete the term of the member or alternate vacating the office.~~

~~SECTION 205.030: QUALIFICATIONS~~

~~The members of said Board of Police Commissioners and the alternates shall possess the qualifications required of other officers of the Village and shall take an oath of office. They shall be subject to removal from office as such other officers of the Village of Riverview.~~

~~SECTION 205.040: DUTIES AND POWERS~~

~~A. The Board of Police Commissioners shall act in an advisory capacity to the Board of Trustees with respect to Police matters. The Board of Police Commissioners~~

~~shall have the duty of interviewing all applicants for positions of Police Officer within the department, whether for full-time hire, part-time hire or reserve status.~~

~~B. A background check must be completed by the Chief of Police and his/her findings will be forwarded to the Chairman of the Board of Police Commissioners, in writing, prior to an interview. Upon completion of an interview, the Board of Police Commissioners shall forward their recommendations in writing to the Chief of Police, who will then forward the written recommendations to the Chairman of the Board of Trustees. The Chairman of the Board will forward the written recommendations to the Trustees.~~

~~C. The Board of Trustees may request the Board of Police Commissioners to investigate a proposed disciplinary action of an officer. Upon notification of such request to the Board of Police Commissioners, it will be the duty of the Chief of Police to supply the investigative information in writing to the Chairman of the Board of Police Commissioners. The Chief of Police, with the approval of the Board of Trustees, shall require persons with any information to attend any investigatory hearings of the Board of Police Commissioners.~~

~~SECTION 205.050: MEETINGS~~

~~The Board of Police Commissioners shall keep written minutes of all of their meetings and shall designate one (1) of its own members to act as secretary of the Board. The secretary shall be custodian of all papers pertaining to the business of the Board and shall perform such other duties as the Board shall prescribe.~~

~~SECTION 205.060: SALARY~~

~~The salary of each member of the Board of Police Commissioners shall be as set by ordinance from time to time.~~

Section Two.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the passage and approval thereof.
