

**MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC HEARING HELD BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF
THE VILLAGE OF RIVERVIEW, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, HELD ON MAY 28,
2009**

There being a quorum present, the meeting was called to order by Chairman Steve Paro in order to discuss revocation of the merchant license for Rite-Way Auto, 201 Chambers Road.

Attorney Graville began the meeting by discussing the reasons the Village brought forth the issue of revocation of the merchant license for Rite-Way Auto located at 201 Chambers Road. Building Commissioner Dan Fraley gave testimony regarding the violations observed on the property. Attorney David Drury gave his arguments against the revocation of the merchant's license.
