

**MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC HEARING HELD BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF  
THE VILLAGE OF RIVERVIEW, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, HELD ON JUNE  
25, 2009**

**BE IT REMEMBERED THAT** the Board of Trustees of the Village of Riverview, St. Louis County, Missouri, met at City Hall, 9699 Lilac Drive at 5:35 p.m. on June 25, 2009.

At the time and place, upon roll being called, there were found to be present the following named officers and members of the Board.

Village Clerk Megan Asikainen and Village Attorney Christopher B. Graville were also present as were Attorney David Drury and Moumen Kuziez on behalf of Rite-Way Auto.

There being a quorum present, the meeting was called to order by Chairman Steve Paro in order to discuss the revocation of the merchant license for Rite-Way Auto, 201 Chambers Road.

Attorney Graville opened the meeting by saying that this was a continuation of the Public Hearing held on May 28, 2009. The Board of Trustees discussed various complaints that had been received regarding the condition of the property and were able to ask Mr. Drury and Mr. Kuziez questions about the property. A detailed transcription of the meeting is attached to these minutes as Attachment I.

A motion was made by Trustee Michael Ellington and seconded by Trustee Bruce Stocker to find Mr. Kuziez guilty of violating the municipal ordinances. By roll call vote:

A motion was made by Trustee Michael Ellington and seconded by Trustee Phyllis Paro to reopen the meeting. All Trustees voted in the affirmative, the motion carried. The meeting was reopened at 6:10 p.m.

Trustee Howard Pierce announced that the Village had received one bid packet for the purchase and installation of drinking fountains and the purchase and installation of cement trash receptacles. He opened the bid and read the bid aloud. The bid was distributed to all other Board members for review. A motion was made by Trustee Bruce Stocker and seconded by Trustee Michael Ellington to reject the bid that was received. All Trustees voted in the affirmative, the motion carried.

A motion was made by Trustee Bruce Stocker and seconded by Trustee Michael Ellington to run the advertisement for bids again in an effort to get a better response. All Trustees voted in the affirmative, the motion carried.

With no further business to discuss, a motion was made by Trustee Howard Pierce and seconded by Trustee Michael Ellington to adjourn the meeting. All Trustees voted in the affirmative, the meeting was adjourned at 6:30 p.m.
